Information about the Maritime to Interdisciplinary Studies Pathway:

The list below documents courses approved for transfer between Northshore Technical Community College and The University of New Orleans through the State of Louisiana Board of Regents Master Course Articulation Matrix (http://www.regents.la.gov/page/master-course-articulation-matrix). Articulation agreements are subject to change.

Northshore Technical Community College students who have completed the Associates Degree in Maritime Technology Vessel Operations Track will be admitted as juniors in the Bachelors of Interdisciplinary Studies at the University of New Orleans provided they meet the requirements as outlined in the agreement. All students must meet the minimum requirements for transfer admission to UNO as stated in the UNO Undergraduate/Graduate Catalog in force at the time of their application for admission.

The total number of credit hours required to complete a bachelors degree in Interdisciplinary Studies at UNO is 120 hours. Students may transfer up to 60 credits from NTCC before transferring to UNO. NTCC students who successfully transfer to UNO will earn a bachelors degree in Interdisciplinary Studies from the University of New Orleans after successfully completing the additional required credit hours (68) at UNO and meeting all UNO degree requirements.
