



Silky Sullivan Scholarship

The Silky Sullivan Scholarship was established by The Greater Mandeville Police Foundation, as well as family and friends of Charles “Silky” Sullivan. The scholarship provides the opportunity to pursue careers in the Career and Skill Craft Trades at Northshore Technical Community College and to encourage students of promise and need, who come from backgrounds that might not include aspirations to gain higher education. Silky Sullivan, whose career included being a resource officer for Mandeville High School as well as a Mandeville police officer, was an advocate of technical studies in higher education. This scholarship allows his passion for helping others achieve their educational and career goals to carry-on.

The Career and Skill Craft Trades programs eligible for this award are: Air Conditioning and Refrigeration, Automotive Technology, Building Technology, Diesel Powered Equipment Technology, Electrician, Machine Tool Technology, and Welding.

Awards

NTCC will award 1 scholarship for the 2016-17 academic year up to \$500. Recipients will be awarded in March for the spring 2017 semester. Any debts owed to Northshore Technical Community College must be paid prior to disbursement of scholarship funds.

Eligibility

1. Must be a Resident of St. Tammany Parish.
2. Financial need must be demonstrated. FAFSA must be on file.
3. Minimum cumulative GPA: 2.0 per semester
4. Must be currently enrolled full time in a Career and Skill Craft program at NTCC.

Application Requirements

To be considered, all applicants must complete an application and return it to the Office of Student Financial Assistance by Friday, March 24, 2017. The application must include:

1. A completed Silky Sullivan Scholarship Form
2. A one- page essay describing why the student selected his/her career path. A statement of need should be addressed in the essay as well.

All applicants applying will receive email notification of the committee’s decision

Only completed applications will be considered.
